Fig. 1. One of the activities that the students do is the Video Essay.

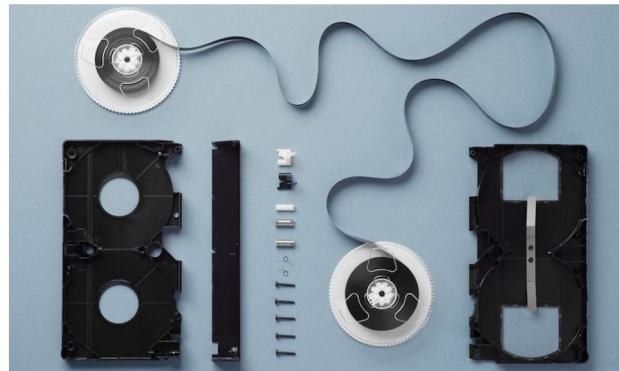


Fig. 2. There are a lot of different tools for making creative illustrative clips and the students learn how to use some of them (source: Mysimpleshow, 2020)
